



Coaching Code of Conduct

1. Always carry copies of the following with you at all coaching session away from Bolton Arena:
 - Most recent Coaching Certificate
 - FA 1st Aid Certificate
 - FA Child Protection Certificate
 - Staff Pass & FACA Card (if a member)
 - Public Liability Insurance Certificate
2. Always aim to arrive at the coaching session 15 minutes before the start of the session.
3. Always conduct yourself in an appropriate manner in and around the school/venue.
4. Mobile phones should be switched onto Silent and only used if necessary, if so excuse yourself from the group and teacher.
5. Ensure all equipment is clean and in full working order. Including a First Aid Kit.
6. Dress appropriately, including footwear. When wearing shorts and football socks ensure football socks are pulled up.
7. Coaches must be Clean Shaven and presentable.
8. Jewellery worn should be kept to a minimum.
9. No Chewing Gum whilst coaching.
10. Always conduct an introduction at the start of the session, introduce yourself, the Charity, and the session you will be coaching. Conduct a de-brief, and ensure the group leave the session in the correct manner and safely, signing them out where applicable.
11. Where possible, set up the coaching session prior to engaging the group.
12. Always deliver the coaching session to the highest standard and to the best of your ability.
13. Make all coaching sessions as fun, enjoyable, and beneficial as possible.
14. Always use appropriate language for the group you are working with, and the environment you are working in.
15. Always place the well being and safety above everything.
